

RULES RELATING TO BURIAL AND BURNING GROUND

1. The Committee shall prepare a register of all the existing burial and burning grounds in use within Municipal limits. This register shall be published by posting copies thereof in conspicuous parts of the town, for the information of the public; all objections, which any person may wish to make with respect to the said register, shall be filled within two months of the said publication. After these objections, if any, have been considered, the Committee shall revise the register, which shall be maintained in the Municipal Office. No place not duly registered shall be used as a burial or burning ground thereafter without the express permission of the Committee in writing.
2. No person shall bury any corpse, or cause it to be buried in a grave the depth of which does not allow three feet of earth between the surface of the ground and the dead body.
3. No person shall make, or cause to be made, a grave in any burial grounds at a less clear distance than two feet from any existing grave.
